TASTING NOTES

From two noble vineyards, the Pinot Noir fruit for this debut release of Royal Princess Rosé hails from the heart of the Russian River Valley. Cool, foggy nights, balanced by daily sunshine and verdant terroir, provided the perfect balance to create this rosé. The grapes were picked expressly to make rosé, and whole cluster pressed to retain essence and its stunning color.

Vivid pale salmon in the glass, the 2018 Royal Princess manifests vibrant aromas of lush peach, California blood orange and a hint of salinity. Plush yet focused, flavors of guava, wild strawberry, and grapefruit gently ambush the palate. Bright acidity accentuates a long, mouthwatering finish. Pair this beauty poolside with good company, a bucket of ice and your favorite summer playlist!
