TASTING NOTES

The Santa Maria Valley in the northern extreme of Santa Barbara County produces some of the most nuanced, textured and refined Pinot Noir in California. The pedigreed sites that we work with here are known for cold, fog-filled mornings and warm, sun-drenched afternoons that lend to the bright cherry and savory characteristics of the fruit.

The 2017 shows balance and richness with aromas of dried cherries, Dijon mustard, violets and baking spices. It's garnet in color, viscous and supple, and expresses vibrant flavors of pomegranate and black cherry. The tannins are plush, smooth and balanced by vivid acidity.
